If it is just cold and dry, then walking boots or trainers would be ideal. All children will need to bring a packed lunch however, children can order a packed lunch via their Foodhub account. If you require a school packed lunch, please ensure that this is ordered by Tuesday night. Your child should also bring a bottle of water and a snack to eat mid-morning. Please do not send sweets or chocolate. Mobile phones are NOT allowed.
