P.E

Year 4 will continue to have their P.E sessions on a Tuesday and a Friday. During our P.E lessons this half term, we will be focusing on passing and moving and dribbling, movement and teamwork in invasion games.

Design Technology - Drain Your Drinks

Pupils will work through the following scheme to design a delicious smoothie using fruit and vegetables, and no added sugar. They will then create a smoothie,

Science - Food and the Digestive System

This project teaches children about the human digestive system. They will explore the main parts, starting with the mouth and teeth, identifying teeth types and their functions.

Maths

During our Maths lessons this half term, we will be focusing on a variety of topics: place value, addition and subtraction.

We will also be continuing to practise our arithmetic and times table knowledge.

English

Our English work this half term is based around our science topic the digestive system. We will be developing a recount based on the 'Journey of a Sweet' as well as expanding our knowledge of the Year 4 SPaG objectives.

This will help children understand their responsibilities and rights and how they can ensure these are upheld.

History - Invasion

During this History topic this project teaches children about life in Britain after the Roman withdrawal. Children will learn about Anglo-Saxon and Viking invasions up to the Norman conquest.

MFL

In our Spanish lessons this half term we will be Aprendo Espanol. This is our first half term learning Spanish so this unit is all about learning about Spain!

Computing— The Internet

Children will develop an understanding of the World Wide Web and be given opportunities to explore it themselves.

Art - Contrast and Complement

This art project will teach children about colour theory by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. We will also explore how artists use colour in their work.

R.E— Prayer

During this unit, children will learn about prayer as a way to communicate with God. We will also be exploring how believers all over the world pray in many different ways.

Geography— Interconnected World

This essential skills and knowledge project teaches children about compass points and four and six-figure grid references. They learn about the tropics and the countries, climates and culture of North and South America.
