P.E

Year 6 will continue to have their P.E sessions on a Wednesday and Friday this half term. The focus of our P.E sessions will be Forest School /Football and Net-ball.

Design Technology - Eatwell

During this Design Technology topic, children will research, design and make a healthy pizza and side dish. Afterwards, the pupils will evaluate their product.

Science - The Circulatory System

This project teaches children about the transport role of the human circulatory system, its main parts and primary functions. They will learn about healthy lifestyle choices and the effects of harmful substances on the body.

Maths

In our Maths lessons this term, we will continue our work around the four operations. We also be improving our understanding of fractions, learning to divide and multiply them. We will also begin our work on converting units of measure.

English

Our English work this half term is based around our class novel the Arrival, where we will be writing a 1st person narrative in role. We will also be continuing to learn and recap Year 6 SPaG objectives.

PSHCE - Being Me in my World

This will help children understand their responsibilities and rights and how they can ensure these are upheld.

History - Maafa

This project teaches children about Africa past and present with a particular focus on Benin. It looks at the development of the slave trade and Britain's role in the transatlantic Slave Trade.

MFL

In our Spanish lessons this half term we will be Las Verduras. In this unit, children will learn the names of 10 common vegetables.

Computing— Systems and Networks

This unit helps children to understand how data is transferred over the internet. We will also be exploring how to communicate responsibly online.

Art - Tints, Tones and Shades

This art project teaches children about colour theory by studying the colour wheel and exploring mixing tints, shades and tones. We will also look at the features of significant landscape artists.

R.E— Life as a Journey

During this R.E unit, we will be exploring life as a journey and what it means to make that journey as a Christian. We will also develop an understanding of a religious pilgrimage.

Geography— Our Changing World

This unit of work revises essential skills and covers the features of the Earth, time zones, lines of latitude and longitude and how to pinpoint places on a map. We will also analyse road safety data and take part in local fieldwork.
