Year 5



P.E

Year 5 will to have their P.E sessions on a Monday and a Tuesday. During our P.E lessons this half term, we will be focusing on dance and gymnastics whilst taking part in Forest School.

Design Technology – Snack Attack

This project teaches children about the importance of healthy snacking. We will also be learning food preparation and cooking techniques linked to this.

Science

Human Reproduction and Ageing

This project teaches children about animal life cycles, including the human life cycle. They explore human growth and development to old age, including the changes experienced during puberty and human reproduction.

Maths

This term we will be furthering our long multiplication and short division skills, before building and expanding upon our prior knowledge of fractions and decimals whilst introducing percentages.

English – The Lost Thing

We will be exploring the text and film stimuli 'The Lost Thing' and engaging in the themes of the story, before exploring the structure of the fantasy narrative and emulating it ourselves.

Home Learning Activities

Design Technology—investigate what snacks your friends and family like? Collect data and present it as a table or a graph. How can your friends and family make healthier choices?

Geography—Do you know anyone with an allotment/grows food? Talk to them about what is involved in growing food? Or try growing your own!

RE—Create a piece of writing about somebody who inspires you. Who is your role model? Why? Think about someone who has become victorious despite it seeming impossible.

MFL – Me Presento (I am)

We will be learning a new set of vocabulary and learning how to describe ourselves in Spanish.

Art—Surface and Colour: Painting, Collage and Fashion Design

We will create a collage design inspired by fashion.

R.E – Jesus

We will be exploring why Christians believe that Jesus was a great teacher, to do this we will reflect upon a number of parables.

Geography – Sow, Grow and Farm

This project explores the features and characteristics of land use in agricultural regions across the world.

Computing – Programming A: Selection in Physical Computing
