We'd love to hear how the children have shown our value outside of school. Please do send messages to your child's class teacher detailing an example. Thank you 😊

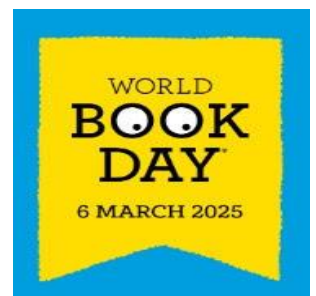
Parents Evenings
