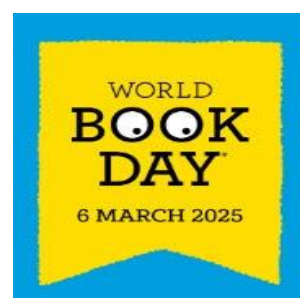

Reporting Absences

Please can we ask that parents report all absences via the phone and do not email into school. We have a dedicated line to report absences and these messages are picked up first thing in the morning. Please do not message teachers via Class Dojo to report absences, home-time arrangements or appointments. These should all come via the school office. Thank you.

Parking

Please can we once again ask parents to be considerate to our pupils, parents, other drivers & residents when dropping off and picking up their child from school. The problem gets significantly worse in bad weather, when more children are being brought to school by car. We regularly receive phone calls from residents about cars blocking homes & preventing residents from getting off their own driveways.

We have also witnessed many cars pulling into the staff car park and using it as a turning circle and putting our children at risk. Parents should not come on to the staff car park and should not park there at the end of the day, when collecting children at 3.30pm or from after school clubs at 4.30pm. The staff car park is for staff and visitors only. As a school we will be monitoring this situation closely, alongside our local PCSO, who will undertake random checks. (The only exception for the use of our car park, is for parents coming early in the morning to drop their child off at Breakfast club).

We are dedicated to the safeguarding of all our children and very much appreciate your help & co-operation with this matter.
