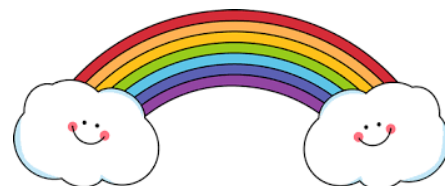
### School Sunday (Theme – 'Our School Values')
